

## TAALERI ENERGIA LTD'S WEBSITE POLICY

### GENERALLY

We use a range of different technologies on our website, some of which are controlled by ourselves (first party) and some of which are controlled by other organizations (third party). These technologies include (but are not limited to) cookies, web bugs, scripts, fonts and images; some of which are considered as necessary for us to be able to deliver the web site to you and others which we use to enhance our understanding of how you use our web site; to assist in our marketing activities and other purposes as explained below

Under the Act on Electronic Communications Services of Finland (917/2014), we are required to obtain your consent for any use of these technologies which is not considered as necessary, as well as provide you with clear information as to what these technologies do.

### ABOUT COOKIES AND WEB BUGS

We use cookies and web bugs to collect data. Most of the data are not personal data, but cookies and web bugs can also collect data classified as personal.

A cookie is a small string of characters that a website can send to the browser. Cookies cannot pick up data from your computer, spread viruses or capture email addresses. Taaleri Energia uses both session cookies and persistent cookies in order to enhance the experience of using the website. With cookies, it is possible to follow, for example, the use of the different sections of the website and the selections made by users. If you do not wish to accept cookies, do not consent to cookie use or change the settings of your browser. For example, we use the third-party cookies of doubleclick, Google and Youtube.

A web bug is a small transparent GIF image, which is embedded into an HTML page or email message. It can monitor when a page or email message is opened. Through similar technology, a product or service can send data to a server based on what the user does, for example when a user makes a selection. It is reminiscent of cookies in that they both monitor the use of content and only the server receiving the data can read the data. They differ from cookies in that they are not browser-based, they do not recognize users and they do not store anything on the computer.

The common name for such technology is 'data gathering tools'.

On most browsers, a settings menu can be opened on the menu bar. This can be used to find instructions for changing browser settings, if you want, for example, to block new cookies, receive a notification about new cookies or completely remove cookies from use. If you do not want to accept cookies from our website or through email messages in HTML format, you can set the browser to notify you before the acceptance of cookies and to block cookies as necessary. A user may also remove cookies completely from use in his/her browser, but then he/she will not necessarily be able to utilize all the functions on the taalerienergia.com website. The performance of certain functions on the site may require the use of cookies.
